

# Electronic Treatment Record System

Designed for Veterinary Reporting to Regulatory Authorities



# Purpose

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The Jockey Club has created the **Electronic Treatment Record System** free of charge for racing regulatory authorities and reporting veterinarians.

As an industry initiative, we believe providing a tool for regulators to collect electronic treatment data could help contribute to the overall welfare and safety of the racehorse.

The program is now ready to be implemented in any jurisdiction or track that would be interested. It has been beta tested in California, with input from various jurisdictions (KY, MD, CA) throughout the last few years.

# Goals

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- Transition from paper to electronic reporting for treatment records that are mandatory to submit to the jurisdiction dependent upon each jurisdiction's rule.
- Improve efficiency from both the veterinarian and the jurisdiction perspective, while maintaining and improving accuracy and precision of data entry.
- Eliminate duplicate work efforts by providing an electronic file that may be uploaded to billing or patient record systems as supplement for notes on administration amounts, times, and inventory items

*(NOTE: not a substitute for full patient records; dependent upon billing or patient record system data import capabilities).*

# Data Storage & Security

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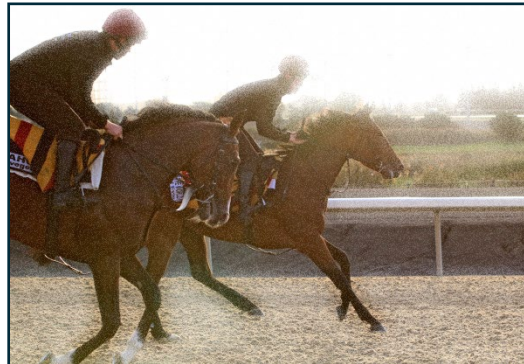
- ETRS database and web services are on its own dedicated server in the Jockey Club Data Center
- Users are required to use complex passwords and those are encrypted before being saved.
- Each racing jurisdiction is also segregated to their own data / web silo.

# Overview

## ETRS

### Reporting Veterinarian (Vet Users)

- Can view and save reports of all users within his/her practice
- Can connect with other vet users within his/her practice
- Can view and save reports of his/her entries
- Ability to Create "Favorite" Items for Quick Report Entry
- Manages Procedure & Medication Inventory



### Regulatory Authority (Admin Users)

- Manages and approves all veterinarian users
- Approves and assigns vet users to practices
- Can view and save all reports of all vet users
- Ability to assign categories to medications for easier sorting
- Manages master medication list

## Reports include:

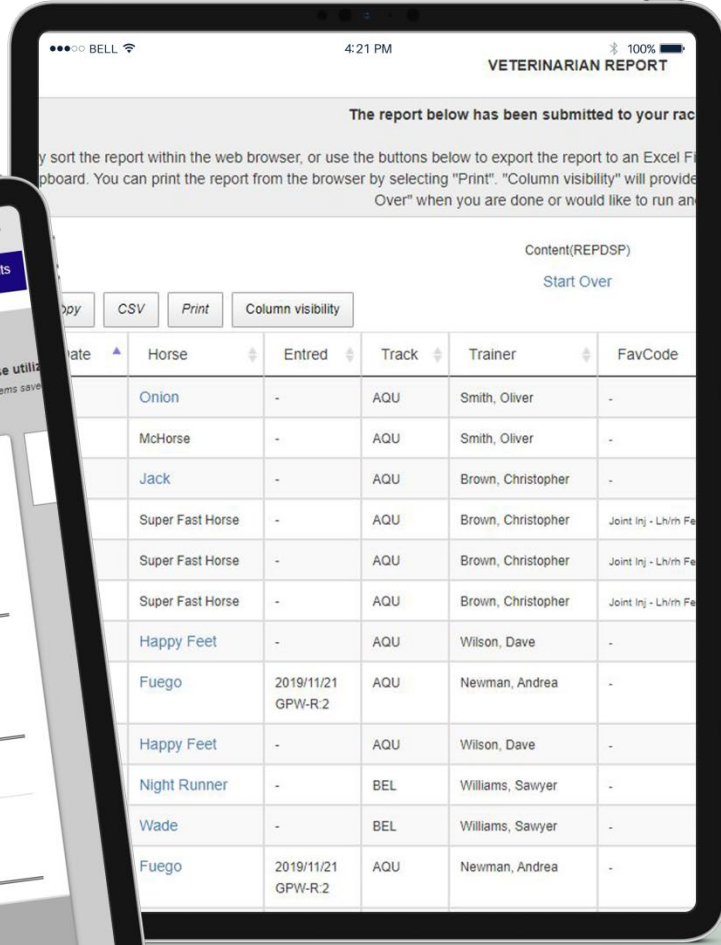
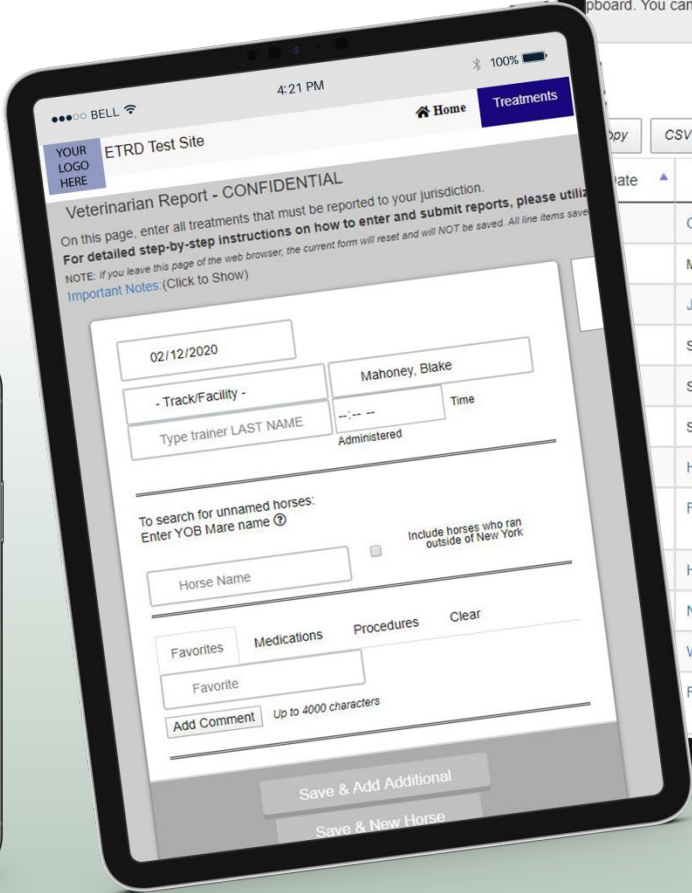
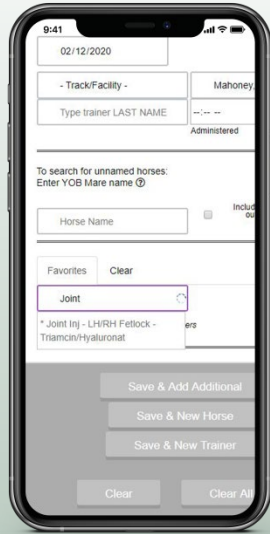
- ✧ **Accurate Horse Names** - Checks against the registered database & flags unknown horses to resolve
- ✧ **Medications** – Vets select from drug list with concentration values for accuracy in reporting
- ✧ **Procedures** – Ability to add any procedure, vaccinations, fluid therapies, examinations, etc.
- ✧ **Race Entries** – Reports generate the a column with the most recent or upcoming entry of a horse

# Veterinarian User

Enters treatments for horses & can generate reports for individual entries or within a practice

Enter on any device with a web browser.

Compatible with desktops, tablets, and smartphones.



# Administrative User

Manages account users & access to all reports submitted in real time with sorting capabilities

You may sort the report within the web browser, or use the buttons below to export the report to an Excel File or CSV. You can print the report from the browser by selecting "Print". "Column visibility" will provide a menu to hide columns and you can run another report.
