Jim Dresher is Founder and CEO of Skye Asset Management, a family investment firm in Maryland. Jim previously founded Skye Hospitality, a Baltimore-based hotel company that developed, owned, and operated hotels within the Marriott and Hilton hotel systems. He is also the owner of Glenangus Farm, a Thoroughbred nursery located in Bel Air, Maryland. Glenangus has produced multiple stakes winners, including Studlydoright (Tremont and Nashua Stakes), a 2022 colt by Nyquist out of Peach of a Gal by Curlin.

Jim was recently elected chair of The Maryland Jockey Club board of directors. He serves on the boards of Johns Hopkins Hospital and Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center, where he recently served as chair. Jim previously served on the boards of John Hopkins Health System, the Greater Baltimore Committee, and the Maryland Horse Breeders Association. He is co-founder of the Maryland Thoroughbred Partnership, an organization established in 2025 dedicated to educating the public on the economic impact and cultural importance of Thoroughbred racing in Maryland. Jim graduated from The Mercersburg Academy and Rutgers University.
