Everett Dobson Chair The Jockey Club

Everett Dobson became chair of The Jockey Club on July 30, 2025. He has been a member since 2014. He served as a steward from August 2017 through August 2021 and was elected again in 2024.

Dobson is a longtime owner and breeder of Thoroughbreds. He is the owner of Candy Meadows Farm, a broodmare farm located in Lexington, Kentucky, and races under Cheyenne Stables. He serves on the executive committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association and is immediate past chairman of the American Graded Stakes Committee. Dobson serves as a member of the Breeders' Cup in addition to being a trustee of the Keeneland Association.

A native and resident of Oklahoma, Dobson is the executive chairman of Dobson Fiber, a telecommunications company based in Oklahoma City. He is also an investor in the NBA champion Oklahoma City Thunder team and serves on their board of directors.
