Marshall Gramm Professor Rhodes College

Dr. Marshall Gramm is a professor in the Department of Economics at Rhodes College. He has more than a dozen academic publications related to the sport of horse racing in journals, including the *Southern Economic Journal, Applied Economics, The American Journal of Economics and Sociology,* and *The Journal of Gambling Business and Economics*.

An avid horseplayer, Gramm won the 2020 Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge and has qualified for the National Horseplayers Championship the last 10 years. Gramm has owned racehorses since he claimed his first horse in 2008. He co-founded Ten Strike Racing in 2016 with Clay Sanders. Ten Strike Racing has more than 530 wins at 30 different racetracks, including 35 stakes races, and it won the owners title at Parx Racing in 2016 and 2017. Gramm has also bred four stakes winners from his modest broodmare band.

Gramm is on the board of the Thoroughbred Idea Foundation, the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, and the Thoroughbred Charities of America. He holds a B.A. from Rice University and Ph.D. in Economics from Texas A&M University.
