Brian Sanfratello has served as executive secretary of the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association (PHBA) since 2014. Prior to that role, he was that organization's board president.

The PHBA has been actively involved in anti-slaughter legislation, including the Safeguard American Food Exports (SAFE) Act and the Carter, Fitzpatrick and Katko Amendment, which would effectively ban horse slaughter in America. The PHBA also supports Pennsylvania-specific legislation that would make it a misdemeanor for anyone who causes or transports a horse into the slaughter pipeline, as well as developing a PHBA code of ethics that would have sanctions for anyone who is a member or registers horses with the organization and is found to be in violation of Pennsylvania anti-slaughter measures

Sanfratello is a retired financial representative and worked at Prudential for 30 years. Prior to working in the insurance industry, he taught sixth grade math at St. Martha Elementary School in Northeast Philadelphia for six years. A former Marine sergeant, Sanfratello served on the Presidential Helicopter Squadron in the Nixon and Ford administrations where he was responsible for security during the president's travel via Marine One. He received two Presidential Citations and two meritorious promotions during his service.

Sanfratello has a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Temple University and a master's degree in secondary education from Villanova University.
