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#### Methodology

PSB conducted online interviews from April 16–21, 2019 among n=700 US likely voters (nationally) and n=500 Kentucky likely voters. As noted in this report, certain questions were only asked of Kentucky likely voters and other questions were only asked of US likely voters (nationally). The margin of error for US likely voters is +/- 3.70% at the 95% confidence level. The margin of error for Kentucky likely voters is +/- 4.38% at the 95% confidence level. Some percentages may total more or less than 100% due to rounding.
