Michael Lopez is the senior director of Football Data and Analytics for the National Football League (NFL) and a former statistics professor at Skidmore College. At the NFL, his work uses data and analytics to enhance the game's competitiveness, officiating, health and safety, and pace of play through rules changes, the creation of new metrics, and the testing and implementation of new technology.

Lopez has written extensively about sports data, including articles for *Sports Illustrated*, *FiveThirtyEight*, and *Deadspin*, and has served as both an associate editor and co-editor-in-chief of the *Journal of Quantitative Analysis in Sports*. In 2020, Lopez was awarded the Significant Contributor award from the American Statistical Association's Section on Statistics in Sports. Lopez earned his Bachelors in Mathematics from Bates College, his Masters in Statistics from University of Massachusetts, Amherst, and his PhD in Biostatistics from Brown University.
