Jeff Novitzky is UFC's vice president of athlete health and performance, spearheading efforts to ensure the health and safety of UFC's roster of more than 500 athletes around the world.

Novitzky has spent the past year partnering with the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) to implement UFC's groundbreaking Anti-Doping Program – the most comprehensive in professional sport. He also oversees the education of UFC athletes on matters of health and performance, including safe weight management and dietary supplement use.

Prior to joining UFC in April of 2015, Novitzky spent several years as a federal agent for the United States Food and Drug Administration, where he led investigations into companies suspected of illegally distributing performance-enhancing substances. Before that, Novitzky conducted Internal Revenue Service investigations into some of the highest-profile anti-doping cases in professional sport history.
